

Complete Exit Counseling Before You Leave NOVA


What Is Exit Counseling?

Exit Counseling is required before you withdraw, graduate, or drop below half-time attendance (even if you plan to transfer to another school). Exit Counseling is designed to help you understand your rights and responsibilities as a student loan borrower. It also provides helpful information about managing your loans and planning for repayment.

How Do I Complete the Exit Counseling?

Step 1: Log in at https://studentaid.gov/. If necessary, you may look up your FSA ID username and password.

Step 2: Click: Loan Repayment > Loan Exit Counseling > Start



Step 3: When you are asked to select a school, select "Northern Virginia Community College" (school code/branch: G03727). Do <u>not</u> select the option with a campus designation as this will result in an error.
