

Green Spring Gardens Horticulture Internship Announcement Summer 2024

Job Title: Horticultural Intern

Description: Green Spring Gardens is a 31-acre public garden with a 1784 Historic House that offers themed

gardens for enjoyment, education and inspiration. Visit our website at www.fairfaxcounty.gov/

The internship will provide a hands-on horticulture introduction to a small public garden. The intern will work in a variety of gardens, learning basic maintenance activities such as watering, weeding, and mulching. The internship will help to hone plant identification skills and provide opportunities to work with experienced horticulture staff and volunteers. Safety and operations training will be provided. Other duties may be assigned. Occasional Saturday or Sunday shift will be required.

This internship is generously funded by the Friends of Green Spring (FROGS).

Compensation: Interns will be temporary, part-time employees of the Fairfax County Park Authority.

Compensation is \$15.86/hour for up to 300 hours. Start and end dates are negotiable.

Requirements: Applicants must be enrolled in a two or four-year horticulture, botany, environmental education

or similar degree program. Applicants must be able to lift more than 50lbs and traverse uneven

ground.
