NOTE. IMPORTANT ***

1. Can Student see Anticipated Aid for the next term?

Yes. Student can see Anticipated Aid when Enrollment begins for each term if student has been awarded for that term.

2. How long will Anticipated Aid be Viewable?

Student will always be able to see the Anticipated Aid amount under View Financial Aid screen.

3. How long will the CLICK HERE to see Pending Financial Aid Based on Actual Enrollment pushbutton be available?

The 'Anticipated Aid Based On Actual Enrollment' will be activated 2 weeks prior to the payment deadline for the involved term and will be inactivated on the Term Census Date (last date to add/drop classes for the full-term session (Fall/Spring – 16 weeks, Summer – 12 weeks)). Once the 'Anticipated Aid Based on Actual Enrollment' function is inactivated, the **CLICK HERE to See Pending Financial Aid Based on Actual Enrollment** pushbutton will be removed.

4. Can students see Anticipated Aid during disbursement?

During the disbursement period, students cannot see the Anticipated Aid amount under the Student Account Inquiry screen. However, they will be able to view their Anticipated amount under the View Financial Aid screen.

5. Does a student have to make payment if he/she has enough Anticipated Aid to cover his/her tuition account balance?

If a student has enough Anticipated Aid to cover his/her tuition account balance for the involved term, he/she does not have to make the payment. However, students must maintain their enrollment since some aid programs have certain enrollment level requirements. For example, loan programs require students to enroll at least half-time (6 credits) for the involved term in order to be eligible for loans. If a student enrolled less than half-time, he/she is not eligible for loans. If a student has only been awarded loans, he/she must make the payment arrangement.
