## 2 Palo Alto VPN Access for Mac

Follow these steps for Palo Alto VPN access for Mac:

1. Log into your Mac with an administrative account.
2. Open a web browser (Safari, Chrome, or Firefox).
3. Enter **vpn.nvcc.edu** in the address bar.
4. Enter your NVCC LAN account user name and password.
5. Click the **LOG IN** button.



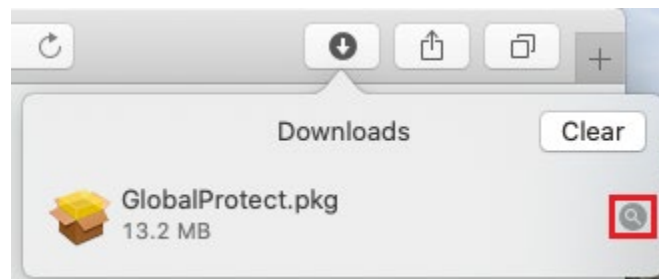
**Figure 1: GlobalProtect Portal**

6. Download the Apple Mac version of the software.
  - a. Select the **Download Mac 32/64 bit GlobalProtect agent** link to download the **GlobalProtect.pkg** file to your computer.



**Figure 2: Download Apple Mac Version of GlobalProtect Software**

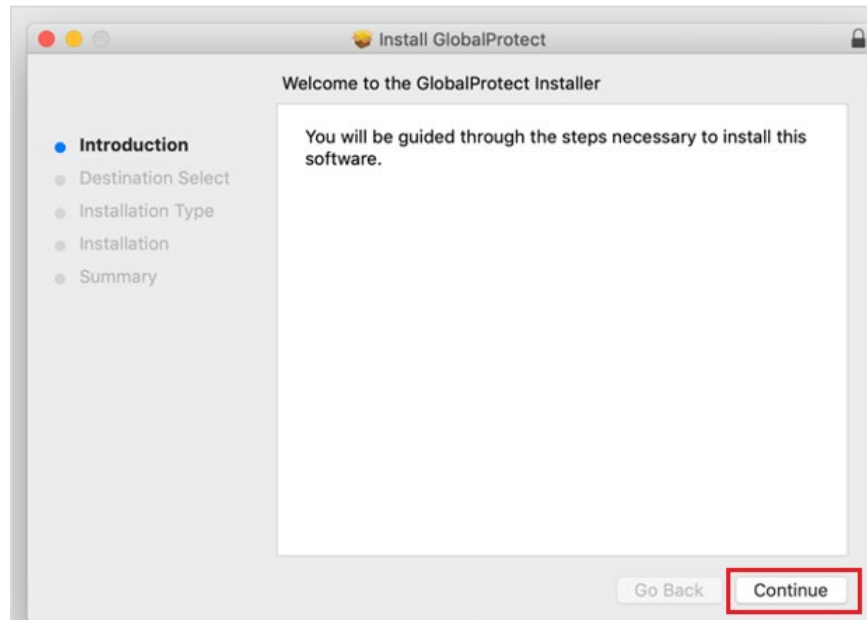
7. Click the  icon to be directed to the Downloads folder.



**Figure 3: Click  Icon**

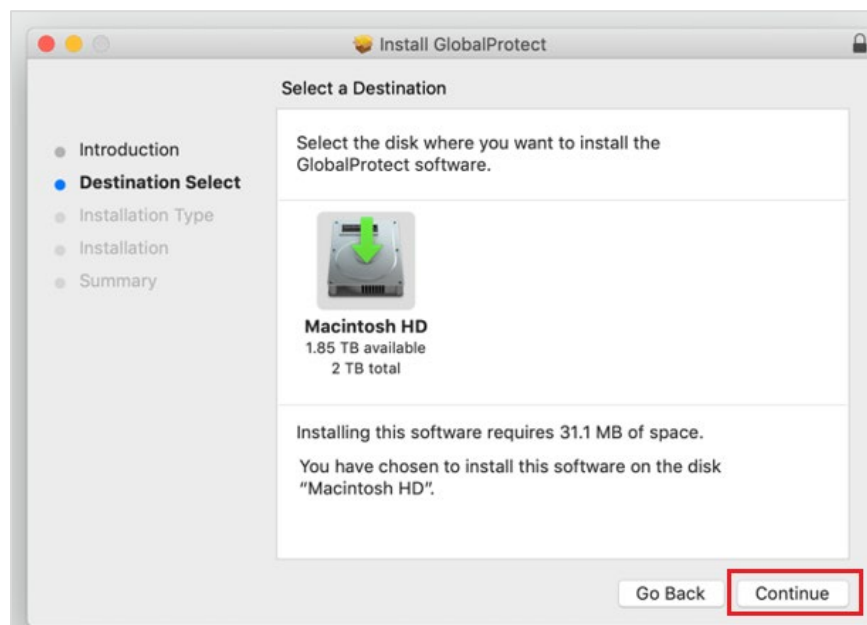
8. Double-click the **GlobalProtect.pkg** file located in your Downloads folder to launch the GlobalProtect Installer.

9. Click the **Continue** button in the Introduction screen.



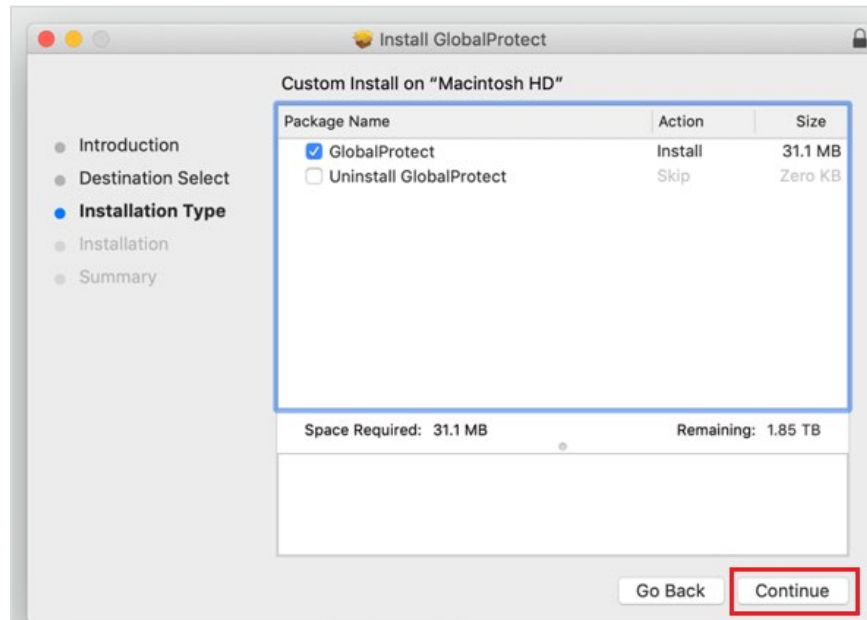
**Figure 4: Introduction Screen**

10. Click the **Continue** button in the Destination Select screen.



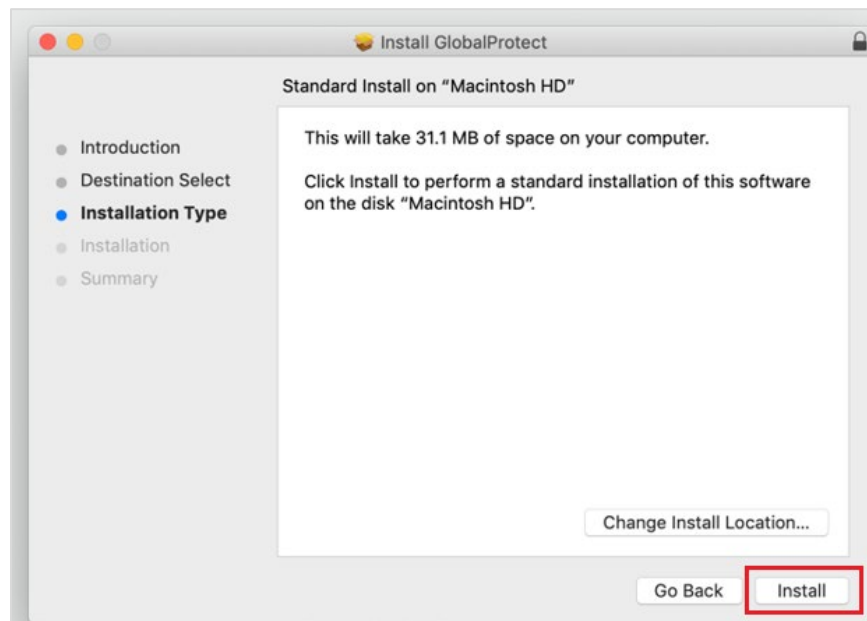
**Figure 5: Destination Select Screen**

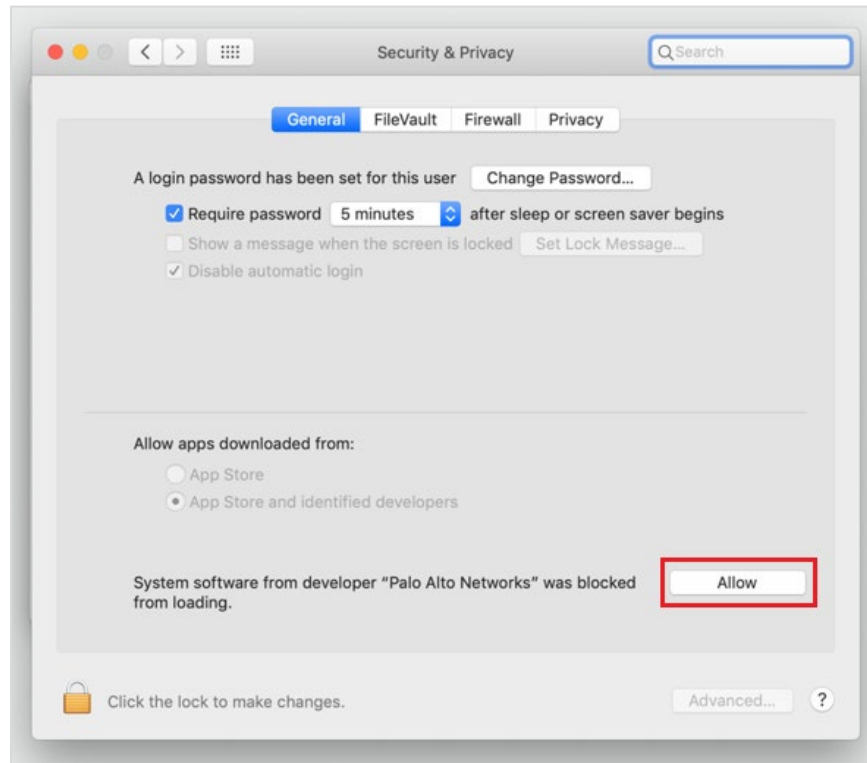
- 15. If prompted, click the **Open Security Preferences** button.

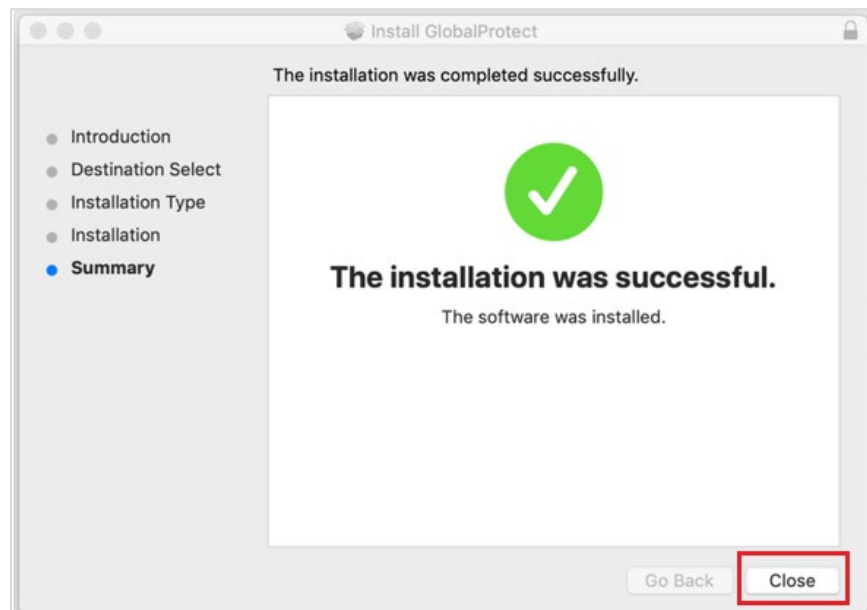


16. Click the **Allow** button in the Security & Privacy screen.

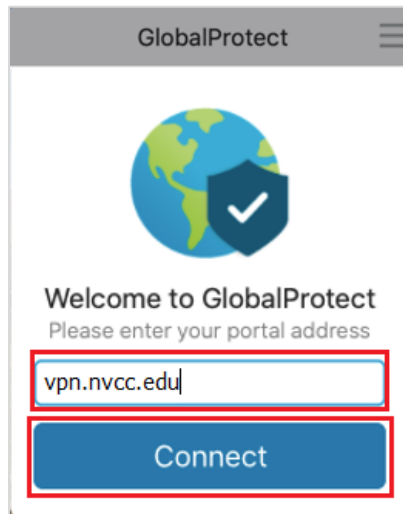
18. Click the  icon in the taskbar to open the GlobalProtect software.

19. Enter **vpn.nvcc.edu** in the Portal Address field.

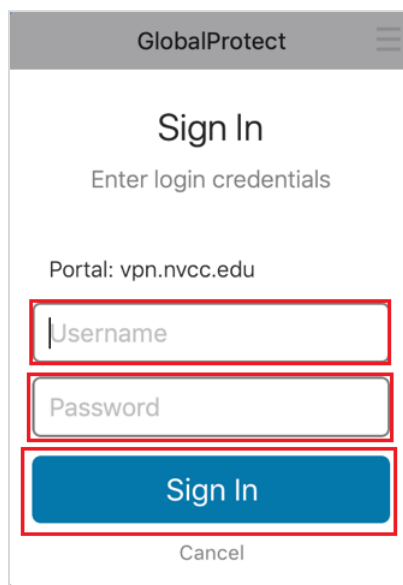
20. Click the **Connect** button.



**Figure 13: GlobalProtect Connection**

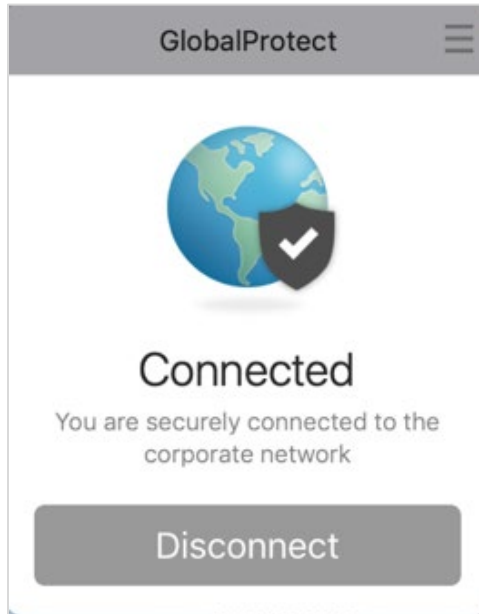
21. Enter your NVCC LAN account user name and password.

22. Click the **Sign In** button.



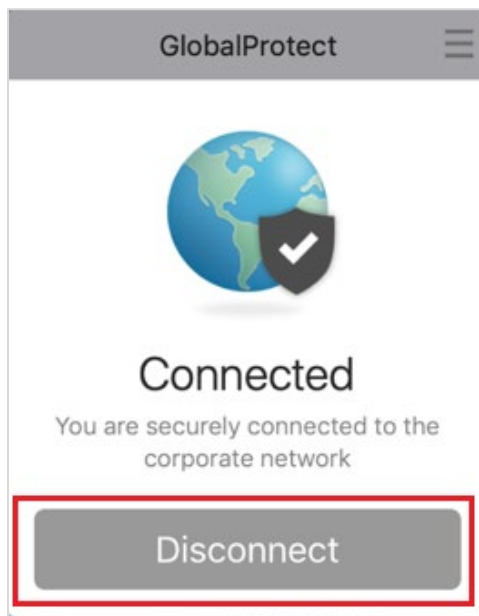
**Figure 14: GlobalProtect Sign In**

23. Click the **Disconnect** button when the session is over to disconnect GlobalProtect.

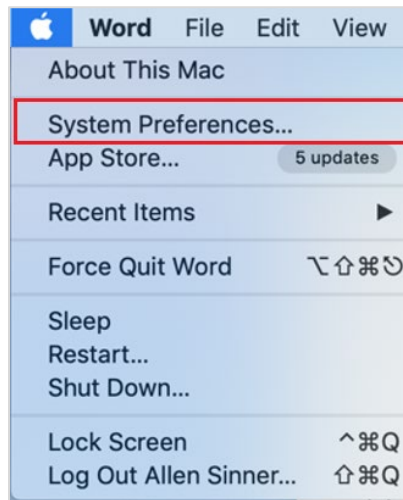


**Figure 16: Disconnect GlobalProtect**

### 3 Troubleshoot Connection Issues

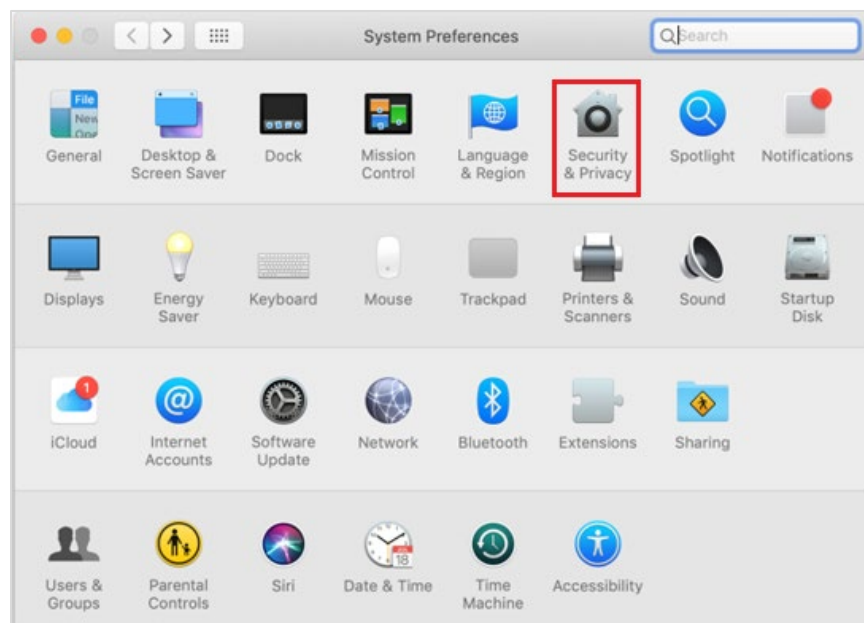
If you do not get the option to enter your user name and password and only see the Connecting from GlobalProtect dialog, follow these steps:

1. Select **System Preferences** from the Apple menu.



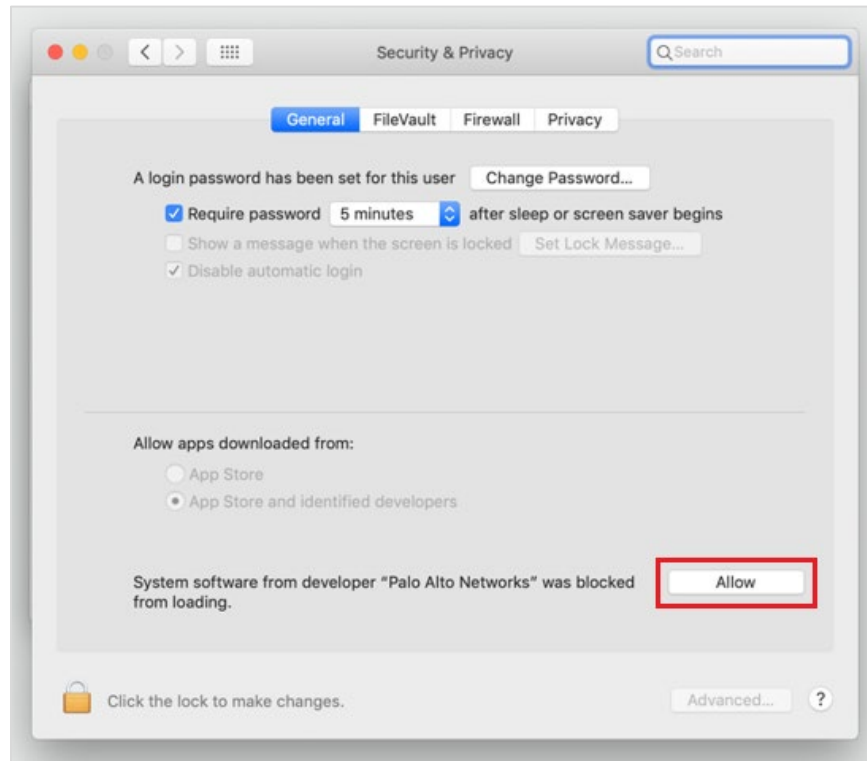
**Figure 17: Select System Preferences**
