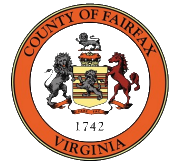


Entry Level Urban Forestry Employment

Forest Health Technician

- Conduct field surveys and collect data
- Implement forest pest treatment activities
- Use Geographic Information Systems (GIS) application to record data

Forest Conservation Technician

- Inspect construction sites for compliance with tree preservation and landscaping requirements
- Perform basic tree maintenance (mulching, watering and pruning)
- Plant trees, often with Fairfax County K-12 students.

Salary: \$18.19 to 24.26/hour

Hours: 20 to 40 hours/week

Minimum Qualifications: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from an accredited two-year college with a degree in urban forestry, horticulture, environmental science, landscape design, agriculture or related field. Must be able to work in harsh terrain and outdoor environments. Must possess a valid driver's license.

Note: *This position may not exceed 900 hours per calendar year. Individuals in these positions are not eligible to earn leave or receive holiday pay.
