## BLACKBOARD APP FOR STUDENTS

Blackboard Student: compatible with iOS 8+ • Android 4.0.3+ • Windows 10+

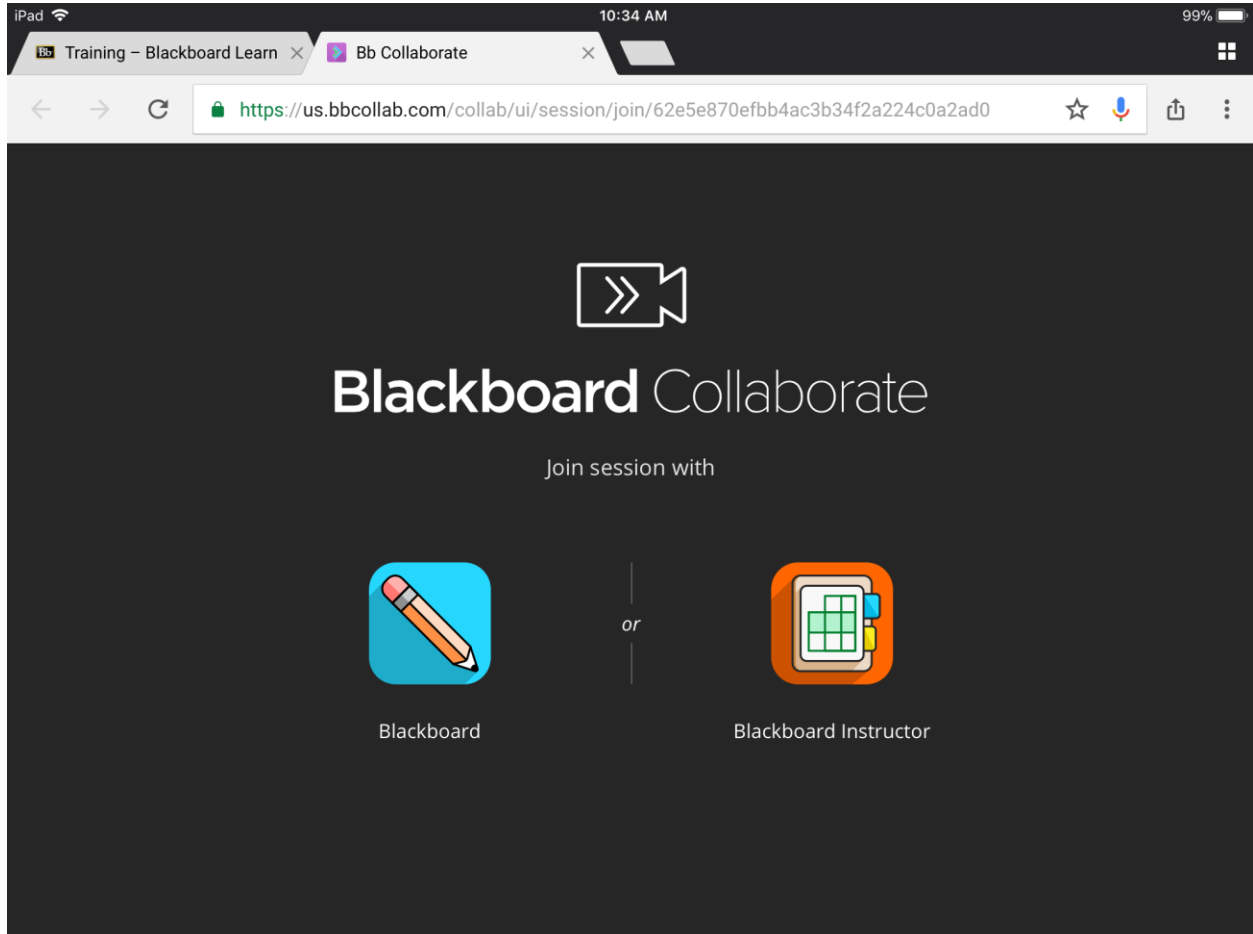


With this app, students can

1. Easily view Activity Stream, the home screen. Which represents a “smart view” of prioritized events and actions and pushes content to the student
2. Participate in discussions from anywhere via a mobile device.
3. View, complete, and submit assignments and tests.
4. Check grades and academic progress in real time.
5. Join virtual classes on the go in Collaborate.
6. With Push Notification activated, Bb Student will keep students up to date and let them know when a test is coming up or an assignment is overdue. Bb Student will also send notifications when new grades are posted.

### Using Bb Student App join Collaborate session

You will need to open the Collaborate session link from your tablet web browser first. And once you click the link, the browser will ask you which app to open the link (see image below). Choose the left blue app for students. If you haven't logged into Blackboard site, you will be asked to log in with your Blackboard credential.
